The focus of this exhibition are Ngarrindjeri history and living culture, colonial heritage and education focusing on the importance of river health.

During an eighteen month process of co-design with The Ngarrindjeri Aboriginal Corporation, local community leaders and Exhibition Studios Yuntulun Ku:li-war (coming together on the headland) has been created and installed within the refurbished iconic Signal Point building.

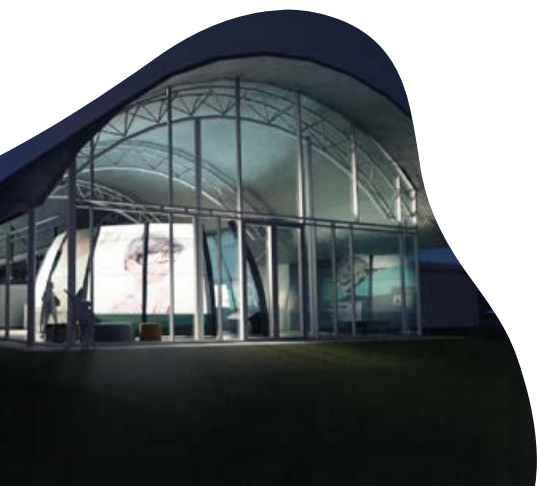
