### Current Charter Fees - Valid until end of June 2023

- Base rate is \$1,040 for 1-2 hour charter.
- Additional hours charged at \$520/hour; eg a 3 hour charter will cost \$1,560
- 4 hour charter is \$2,080
- Half hour increments are OK as long as above 2 hours – e.g. 2.5 hours = \$1,300
- Pricing is inclusive of GST

**Liquor Licence- Please apply at least 4 weeks prior to cruising date to allow ample time and avoid late fees**

- BYO Alcohol is permitted on private charters only. The person booking the charter is responsible for organising a 'Class 1' Short Term Liquor Licence for the Consumption of Liquor on a regulated premises, at their own expense.
- Online application <https://www.sa.gov.au/topics/business-and-trade/liquor/apply/short-term> (Please note, you will be required to create an 'account' to be able to apply for the licence).
- When completing the online application, you will be asked for the Registration Number of the Oscar W. The Registration Number for the Oscar W is 28548.
- Proof of liquor licence must be emailed to [oscar@alexandrina.sa.gov.au](mailto:oscar@alexandrina.sa.gov.au) prior to the charter.
- A hard copy of the liquor licence will be placed on display during the charter.

*Please note- If an Oscar cruise is cancelled for any reason, it is not within our power to provide a refund for your Liquor Licence application. **Liquor licenses are non-refundable.***

**Weather**

- If the weather forecast is 35 degrees or above for Goolwa/Victor Harbor at 4pm the day before, the charter will be cancelled.
- If the weather forecast shows strong winds or heavy rain, the Oscar W cannot sail. The safety of our crew and passengers is priority. We will endeavour to notify you by 4pm the day before your cruise.
- The Captain and Engineer reserve the right to cancel any charter due to unforeseen and or extreme weather conditions.

*If a charter is cancelled to due bad weather, you will have the option to re-schedule your charter, subject to date availability, or request a full refund. Refunds will be processed within approximately 2 weeks of your scheduled charter.*
